The Trolley is being **DONATED** by the Branford Electric Trolley Museum in Branford Ct.


We will need \$5,000, [the shipping cost] available by March 1, 2015, the day the trolley will be DELIVERED. In addition, we will need an estimated \$15,000 to purchase track and ties for installation of the trolley on the track and for restoration of the trolley.

This outstanding opportunity will enhance the Railroad Museum and it will be a major plus for Newtown Township and communities the trolley serviced from 69th street to West Chester. It will certainly bring notoriety and many visitors and Trolley enthusiasts from all over the County and Country.

We also have been in the process of restoring the Pennsylvania 1902 Passenger Coach, donated by the Henry Ford Museum. The Passenger Coach is an all wood platform, Car No. 1444, standard gauge, with carved wood interior, brass luggage rack, gas hanging light fixtures, and green velour seats.
